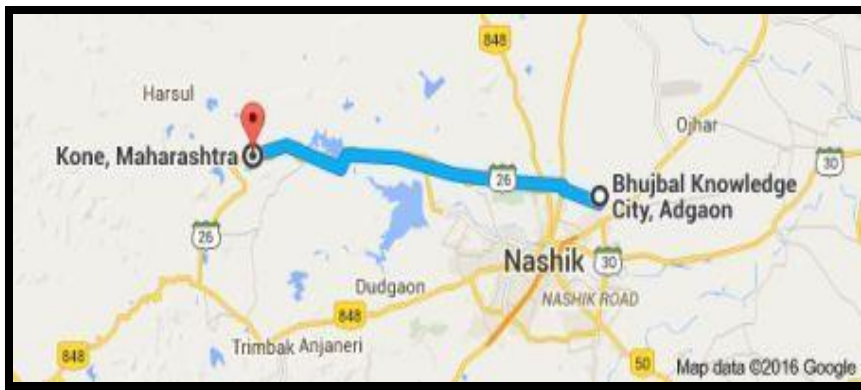

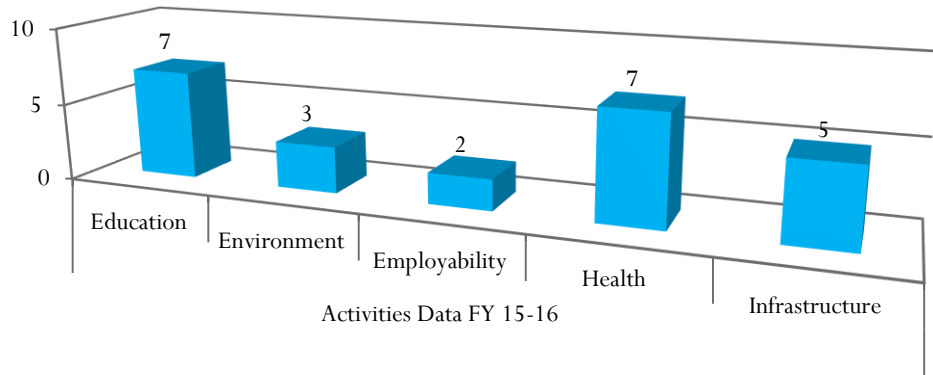

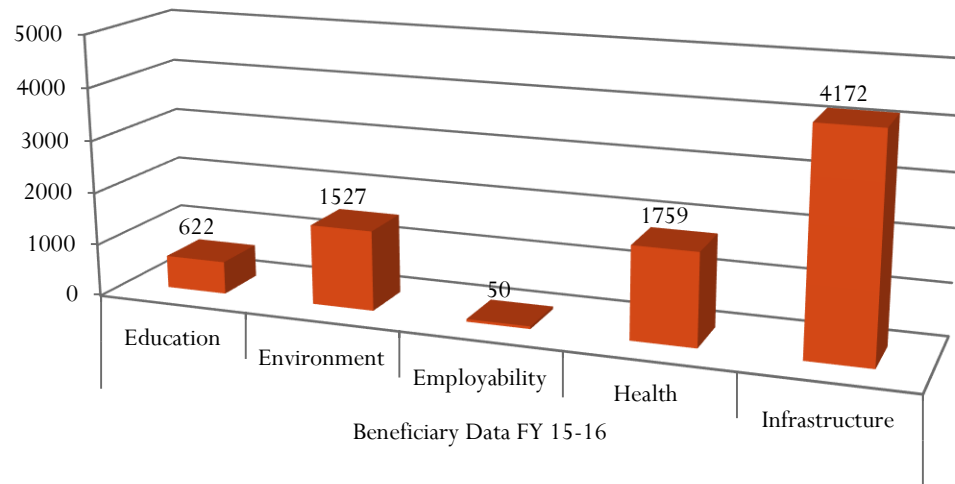

“Jeevan Project”- Provision of Water Pipeline in Nagosali village

Nagosali is a Tribal village in Igatpuri Block. Tribal families in the village were facing water crises due to village politics. Other people banned on their involvement in Grampanchayat.

MET-BKC intervened in major issue & took herculean task of provision of Water facility to tribal peoples in Nagosali. The work took place with people participation. Around 40-45 tribal families got benefitted from this project. There was great satisfaction and happiness on the faces of tribal families.

Swa-Arpan Programme at Kurungwadi village
