




Functions

- Aggrandize CSR by conducting college level events that aims at helping the less fortunate.


Milestones

Activities So Far LaTex Workshop



- Sponsored by the best industries in and around Maharashtra.






- Non paid media coverage during events.

This year, for the METASTORM 2015, we would be introducing a 'New Technical Event' that would promote and groom students for furthering their technical skill set.


Technical Events:

Googled


Where students are given a topic, time and computers, and they have to search on the given topic for the allotted time and present on the same. This even test students' presentation as well as decision making skills.




Jai Ghosh
