Details of the Program

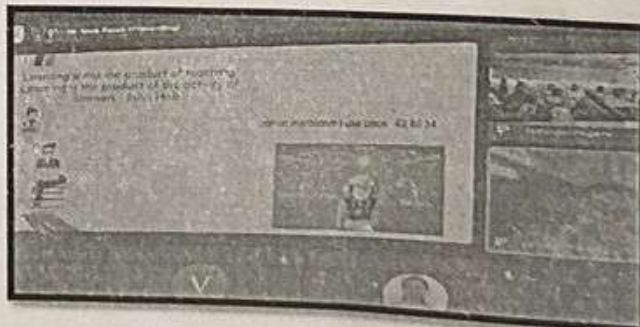
