 - a. Patentability search
 - b. Drafting and filling of provisional and complete specification
 - c. Intimation of publication
 - d. Intimation of first and second examination
 - e. Maintenance fee
 - f. Government fees required from time to time.
5. If the IP seem to be viable for commercialization, MET's Institute of Pharmacy in association with inventor will market the IP or sale to others against royalty.
6. The net earnings from the commercialization of IP can be shared as 50% to the Inventor and 50% to the Institute based on commercial value and mutual term.
7. Trust will decide assignee on the behalf of MET's Institute of Pharmacy, Bhujbal Knowledge City, Nashik.
