
The First Party, represented by Dr. Shailendra Thakare, Director, Nucleus Health Care and research Pvt.Ltd




**Now, Therefore, The First and Second Party** have intended, agreed and consented to the following terms and deeds in pursuance of the common intent:

- The first party shall make available technical training in field of clinical trial.
- The first party shall provide possible placement to students of second party.
- The second party shall provide students for the research and training purpose.
- The Second party shall provide the institute infrastructure and facilities for conducting trainings and workshops. The duration of training will be determined by mutual consents between both the parties.
- Both parties shall provide certificates of the training for all training programs (conducted, if any) to successful participants.
- Both parties shall seek feedback from each participant of training program (if conducted) about overall quality of program, resource persons, etc. 



- The MoU may be terminated at any time during the currency of its period of validity through mutual consent after 30 days, notice from either side in this regard.
- The parties of this MoU undertake to treat as CONFIDENTIAL AND PRIVILEGED information of the other institutions, which is so classified in advance. The terms of confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.
- This MoU will be effective when signed by both the parties and shall remain valid for 05 years term from the effective date which may be extended, from time to time, with mutual consent of both the parties.
