The main objective of this seminar was to sensitize students about entrepreneurship as a career option and what are the various avenues to start an entrepreneurial journey.



Key Outcome of the Activity:

Through this seminar, students were made aware about how they can utilize subject knowledge of pharmaceutical sciences into developing an idea which can be commercialize or which bears some market utility value.


