F.Y.B. Pharmacy Induction Programme 2021**

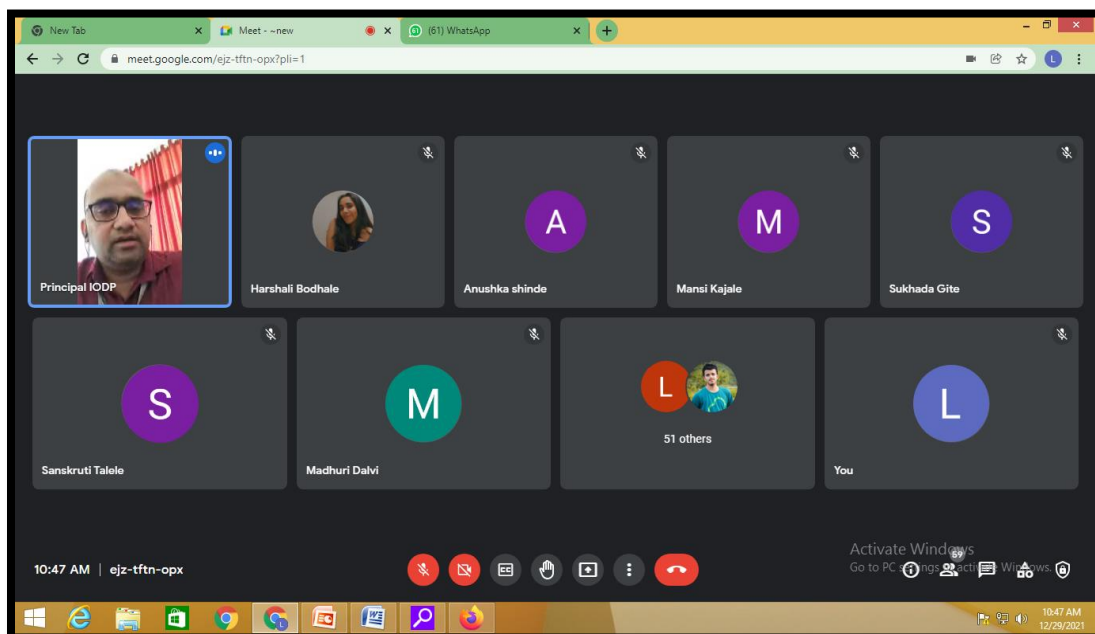

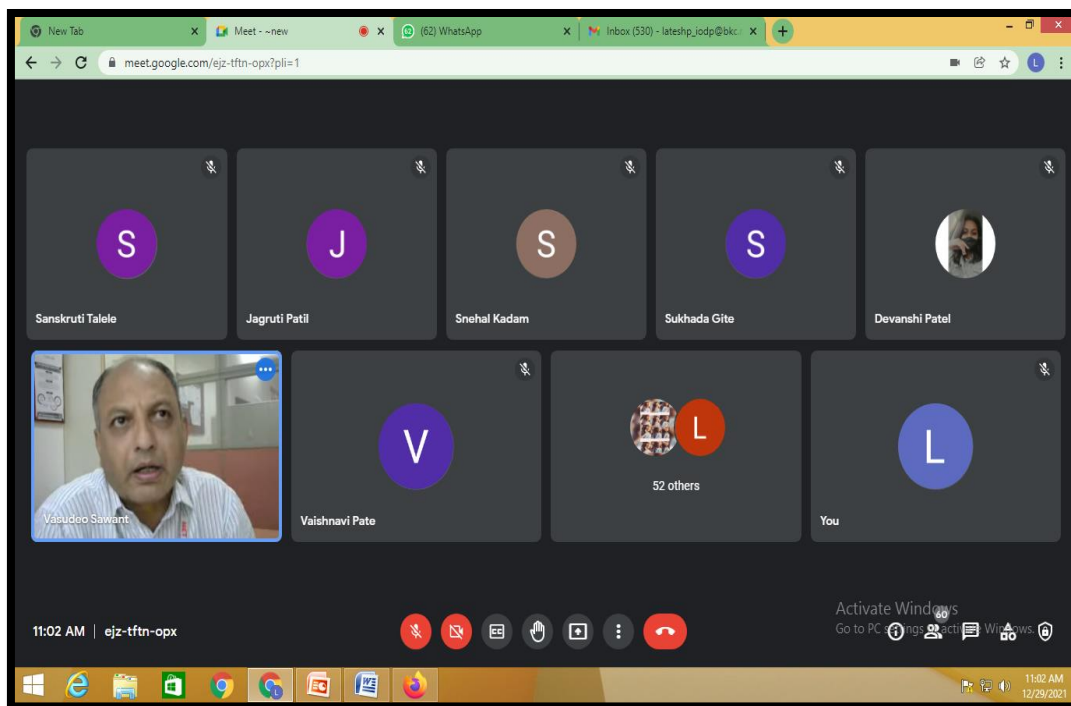

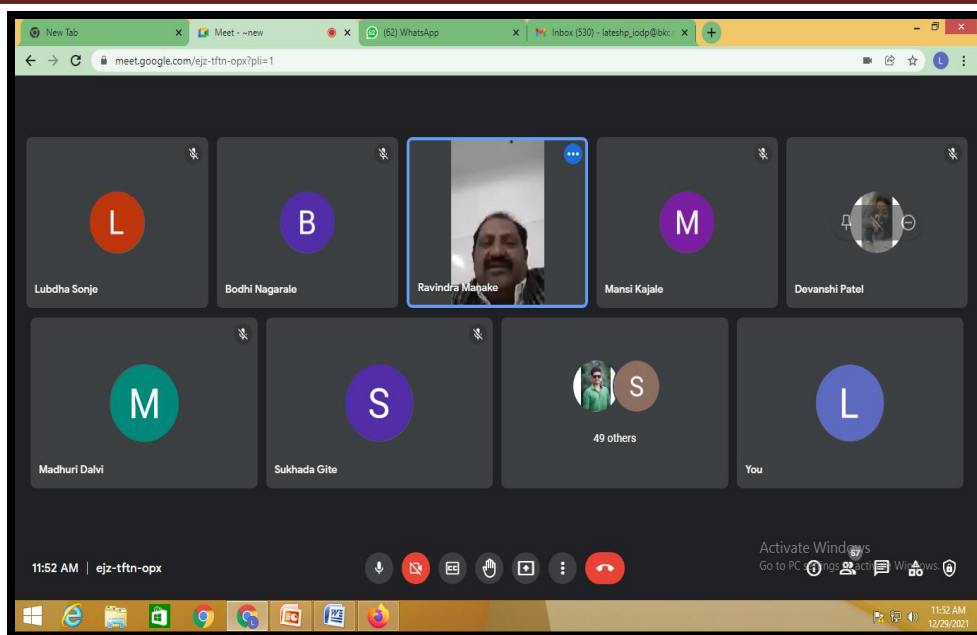


**2] Resource Person:** Mr. Ravindra Manake

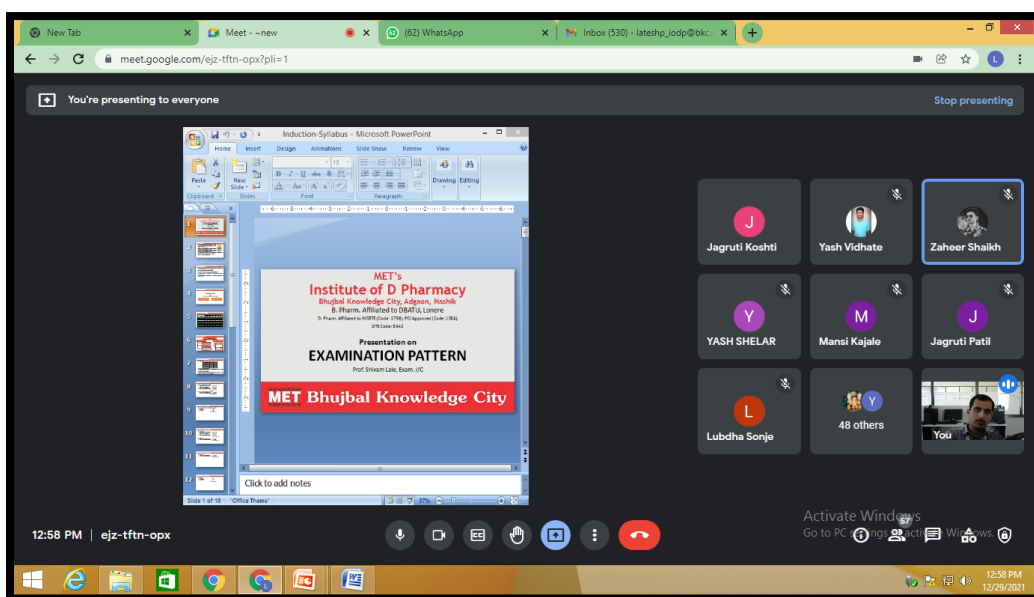


**3]Resource Person:** Mr. Shivam lale

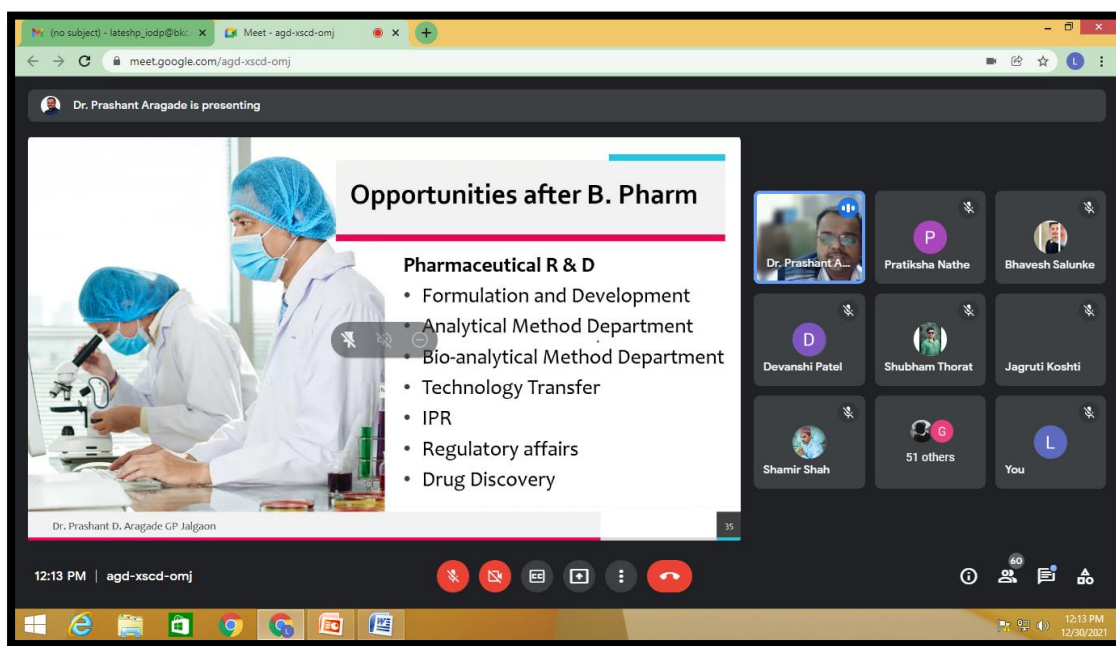

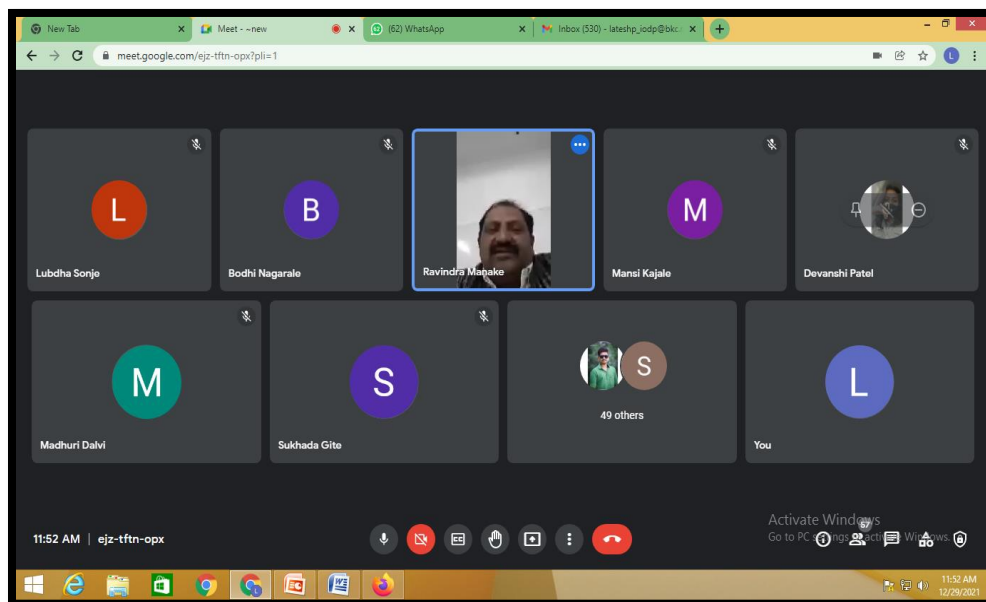


**2] Resource Person:** Mr. Latesh Patil

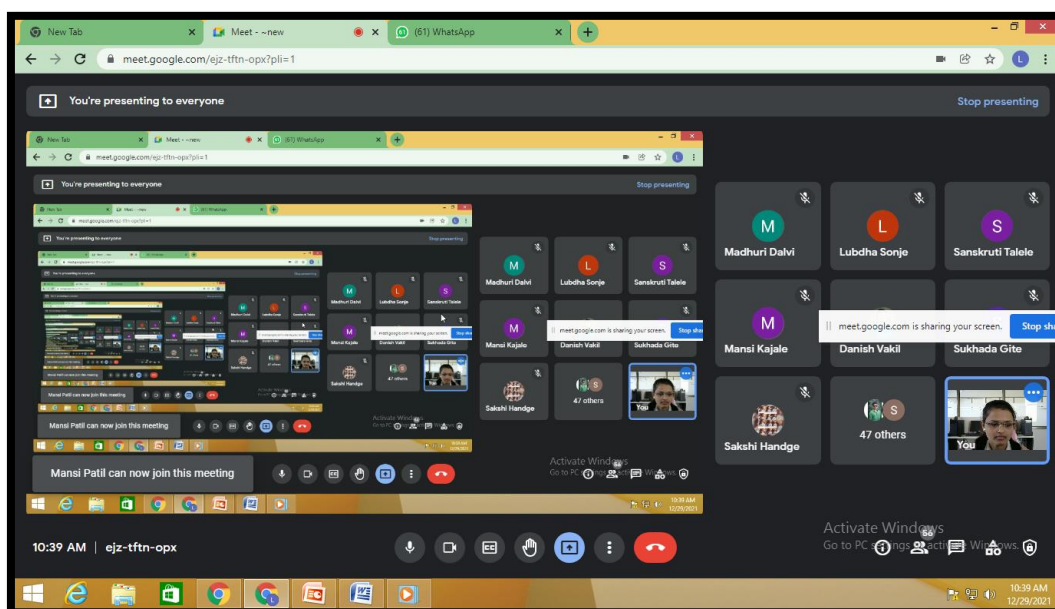


**3]Resource Person:** Ms. Snehal Ukhade

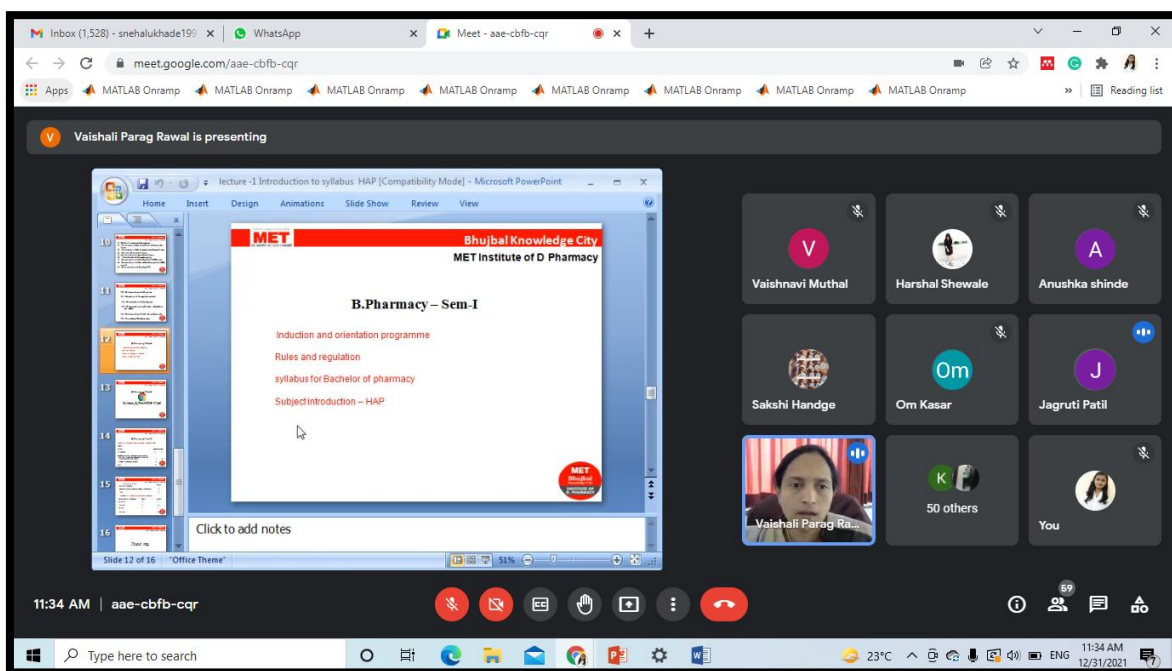
**Day 03: Lecture of Industrial expert and speech by academic in-charge along with the subject introduction of HAP.**

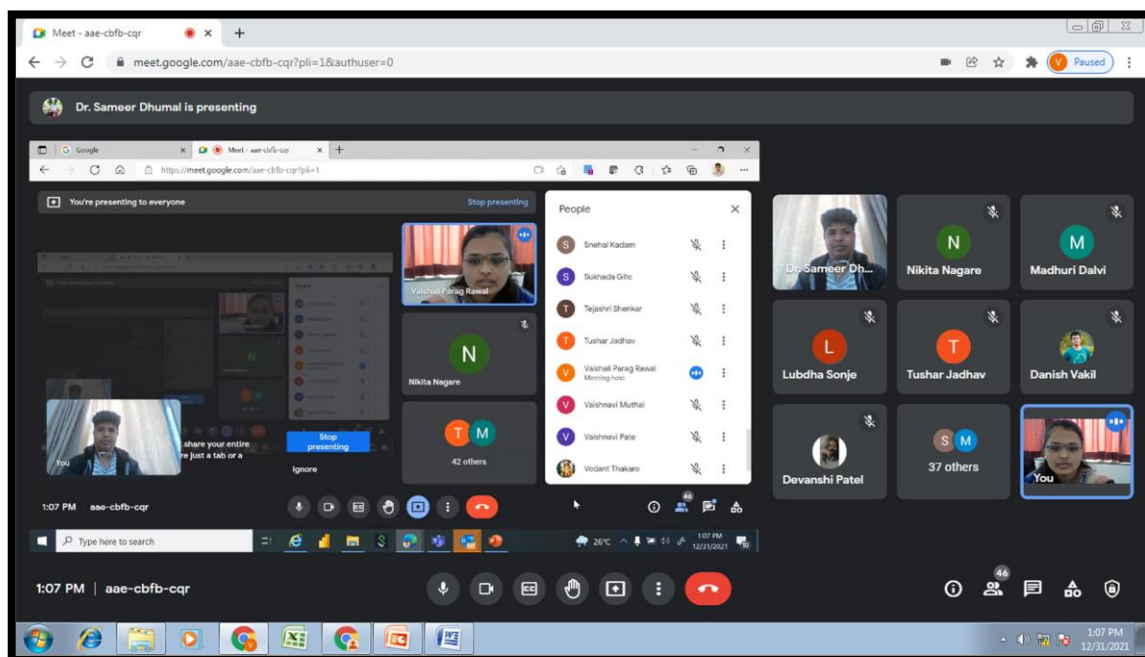


**2] Resource Person:** Dr. Sameer Dhumal
