2) Demand Drafts/Pay Orders

Incase of students have been sanctioned bank loan may use the NEFT facility for payment.

After the fees are paid you will be issued the instructions for joining the online sessions commencing from 15 June 2020.

We shall conduct pilot online sessions by select faculty soon and the time table and other details will be communicated by Institute. Thereafter in June 2020 regular semester will commence online as per time table and protocol which will be communicated to you.

Kindly ensure that fees are paid in time so that you can join the online sessions.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

- 1. All students must wear formal attire for online sessions that they have.
- 2. Students should join the online session with their Names as per Class list & with their own E mail ID via only one device.
- 3. Student should not leave the online session unless the Host teacher asks them to leave or ends the meeting.
- 4. During the online session students should follow basic etiquette such as no mutual chatting, Keep oneself muted unless asked to unmute by the teacher, asking relevant doubts & listening to the teacher attentively.
- 5. Eating or moving around during the session is not allowed.
- 6. Student should participate actively during the class & complete the given tasks promptly.
- 7. Students can ask their doubts to the teacher via the chat option without unmuting themselves.

- 8. Students should be ready to take down notes, keeping any one notebook ready for each subject.
- 9. Student must be punctual i.e. should join each session on time.
- 10. Watch the video twice or thrice and refer the study materials. After, solving the quiz provided with study materials.
- 11. If you have any queries on given topic, then note it down in your note book.
- 12. All students will turn OFF their microphone. Students will only turn ON microphone if it asked by subject I/C.
- 13. All students will always keep their webcam or front camera ON during online session.
- 14. Attendance will be mark if webcam or front camera is ON during online session.
- 15. Attendance will be Consider for further calculation as per examination rules.
- 16. All students are informed to must submit online assignment given by subject teacher timely, because it will be consider for your continuous assessment.

PARENT'S ROLE

For a successful e-learning process parent's support is necessary to support your ward through their learning process.

For parents here is a quick list of general guidelines, every parent should follow to make the online classes a success.

- 1. Motivate your ward to attend the online classes in the same spirit as he/she attends regularly.
- 2. Provide a dedicated place for your ward to attend to his/her online classes without disturbance. Ensure that there is no disturbance when your ward is attending his/her online classes.
- 3. If you do not have a spare computer, then provide technical bandwidth to the cell phone so as to help them to connect with teachers in the session.
- 4. Instruct your ward not to unmute and keep the video ON during the online session (for attendance purpose) and concentrate on what the teacher is delivering. Please explain to him/her that decorum must be maintained and every student is responsible for ensuring that the teaching-learning experience is successful and enriching for all students involved.
- 5. To reinforce concepts, worksheets related to the online classes conducted in a day will be uploaded on the teacher's account. Kindly access the same, using the login ID and the password given by the college to your ward, download them and make your ward do those after the class.
- 6. As parents are at home, its good opportunity for them to monitor their wards academics.
- 7. Please make sure that the device is NOT being charged while in use.
