III. Feedback Summary

The Action Taken Report on feedback for the academic year 2023-24 at MET's Institute of Management, Bhujbal Knowledge City, Nashik, summarizes the feedback collected from students, alumni, and faculty. This report demonstrates the institute's dedication to continuous improvement and fostering a positive learning environment.

Feedback Summary:

- **Students' Feedback on Teaching:** Students rated faculty performance above 3.5 on a scale of 5, indicating overall satisfaction. The Director discussed the feedback with faculty, focusing on content delivery improvements.
- **Alumni Feedback on Syllabus:** Alumni were satisfied with the syllabus for developing analytical skills but suggested incorporating technology courses, updating specialization trends, and increasing industry interactions. These suggestions were reviewed by IQAC for gradual implementation.
- **Teachers' Feedback on Syllabus:** Teachers recommended adding more industry-relevant content and recent case studies. IQAC meetings addressed this and forwarded feedback to the university.
- **Students' Feedback on Syllabus:** Students appreciated the syllabus for enhancing analytical skills and learning values but suggested incorporating recent trends and practical subjects. Plans for add-on certificates and extracurricular activities are in progress.
- **Overall Student Satisfaction:** Students praised teaching, communication, and fairness in evaluation. Areas for improvement included more extracurricular activities and industry exposure, which the institute plans to address through increased sessions and visits.

This feedback reflects MET's Institute of Management's commitment to refining teaching quality and curriculum relevance, ensuring ongoing academic excellence and student satisfaction. The institute will take necessary actions to implement the suggestions and further enhance the student experience.

IV. Result Analysis

Academic Year 2022-23 Result Analysis

MBA First Year:

Total Admissions: 199 students were admitted to the MBA first-year program.

Appeared for Exam: All 199 students appeared for the examination.

Admitted in the Second Year: All 199 students successfully progressed to the second year.

First Year % Result: The first-year pass rate was 100%, indicating that all students who appeared for the examination passed and were eligible to continue to the second year.

MBA Second Year:

Total Admissions: 199 students were admitted to the MBA second-year program.

Appeared for Exam: Out of 199 students, 188 appeared for the examination.

Admitted in the Second Year: 170 students out of 188 were admitted to the second year, indicating successful progression.

Second Year % Result: The Second -year pass rate was 90.43%, suggesting that out of the total admissions, 90.43% of students successfully cleared their first-year examination and were eligible to continue their studies in the second year.

Conclusion: The analysis of the academic year 2022-23 results for both MBA first-year and second-year programs indicates a high level of success and progression. In the first year, all students successfully passed their exams, ensuring a 100% pass rate and progression to the second year. Similarly, in the second year, the majority of students who appeared for the examination were admitted to the following academic year, resulting in a 90.43% pass rate. These

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results reflect positively on the academic standards and student performance within the institute during the specified academic period.
