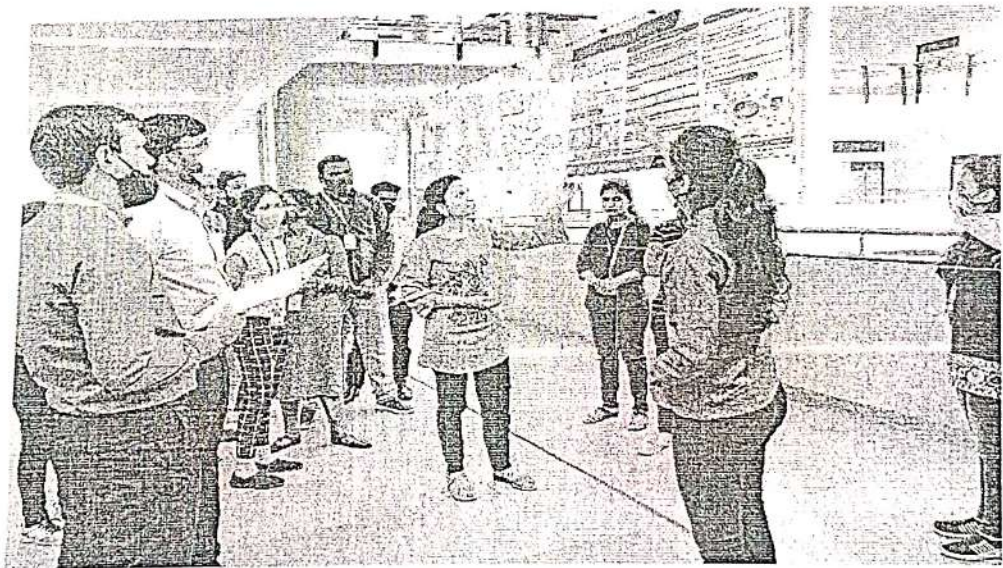
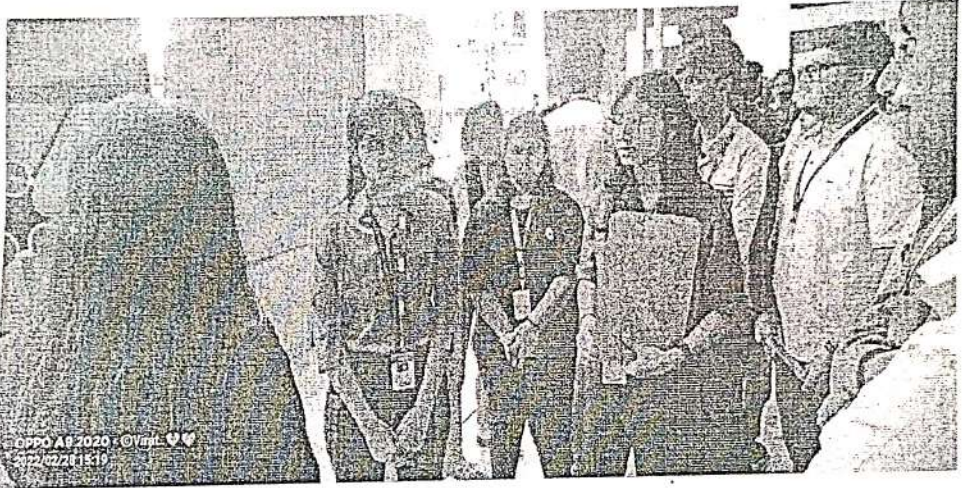
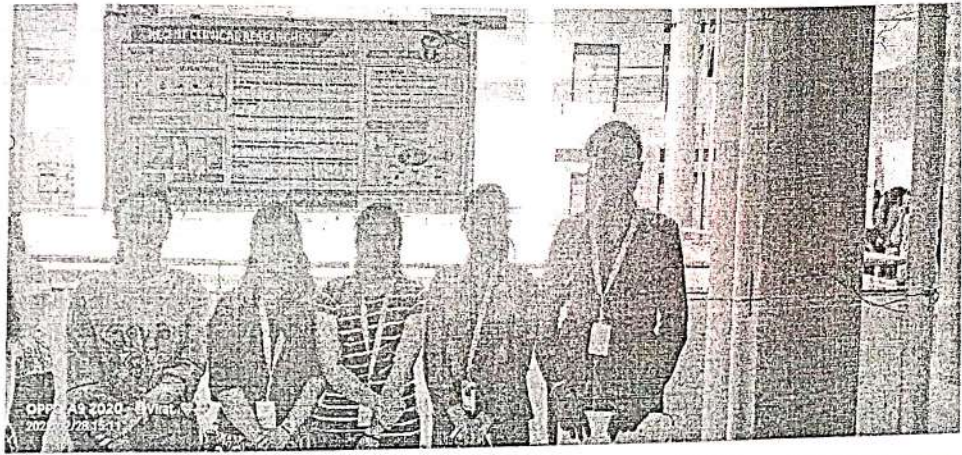
- **Key Outcome of the Activity:**

Dr. Ajay Khopade sir suggested for DST centre. Mr. Samant sir is going to help MET for the same.



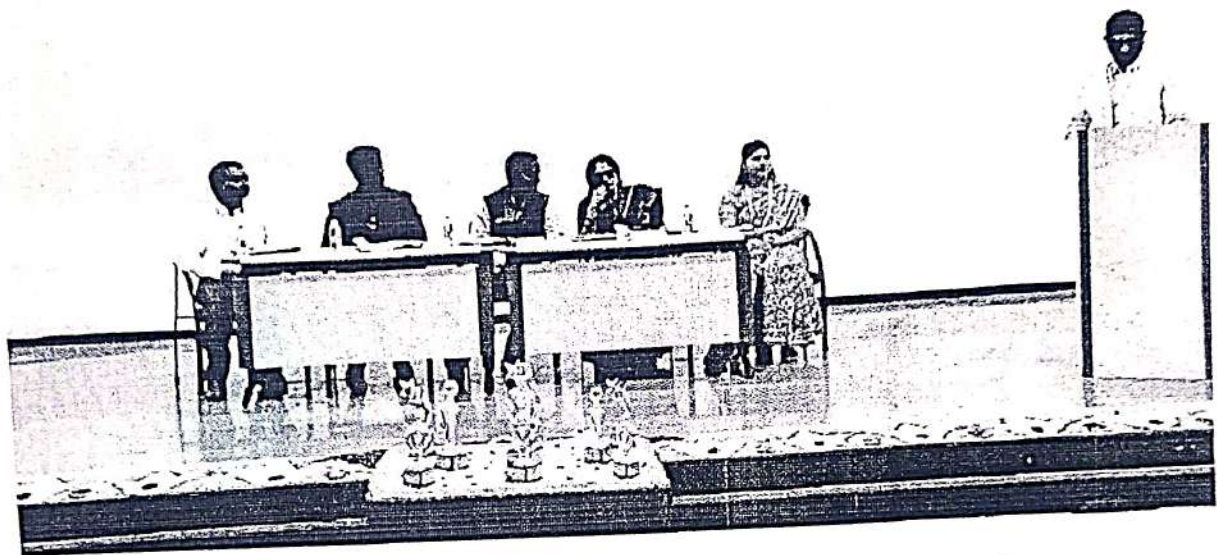
In this competition, 17 colleges participated and a total of 60 groups presented their research projects and a total of 202 participants attended the conference.

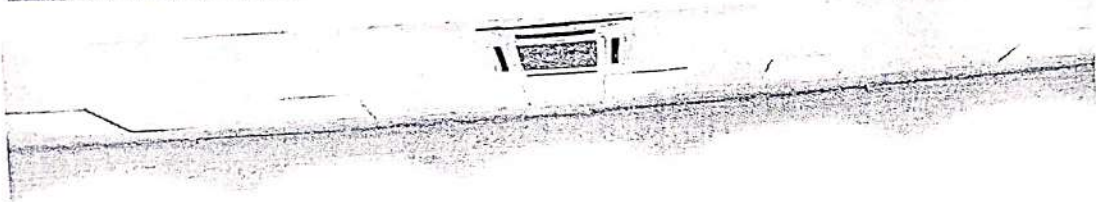

Curriculum Gap Fulfilled:

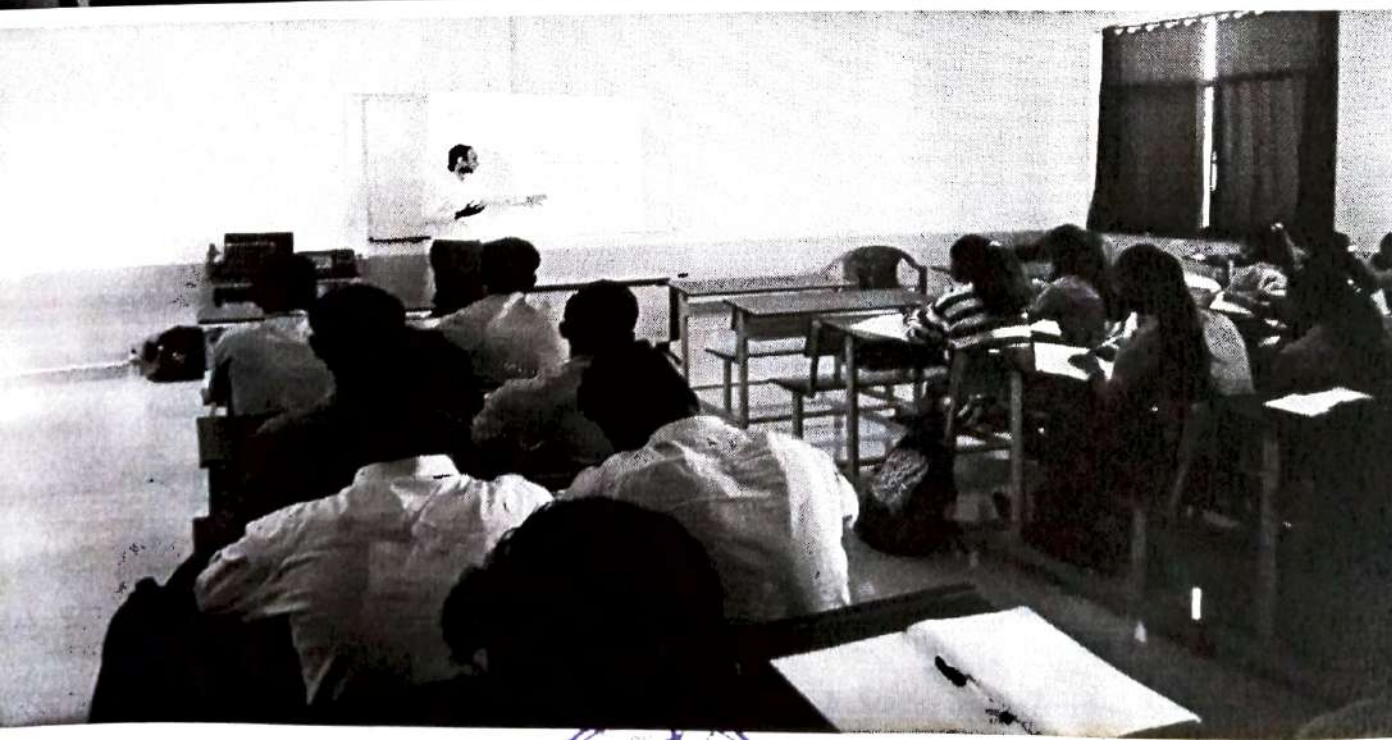
The upskilling program was arranged for the F.Y.D.Pharm. students with a view to improve the students command over English language and to for better understanding of communication and soft skills.

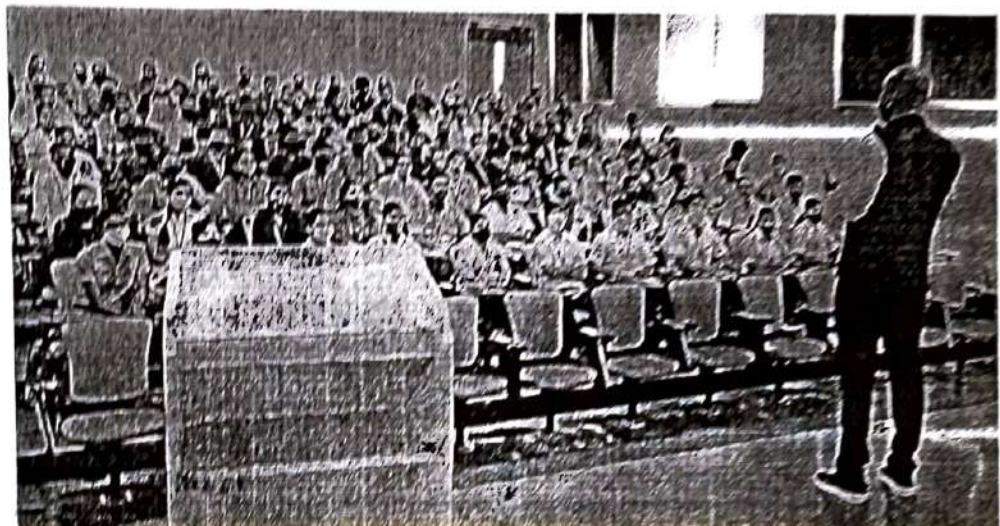
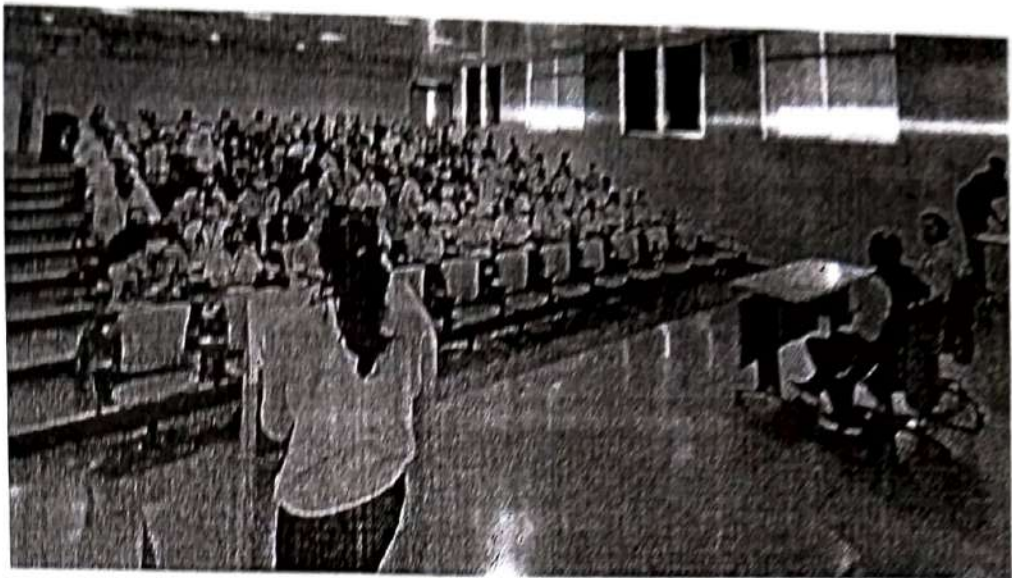
Objectives: The Session was organized with the objective to develop entrepreneurial cultural within students.

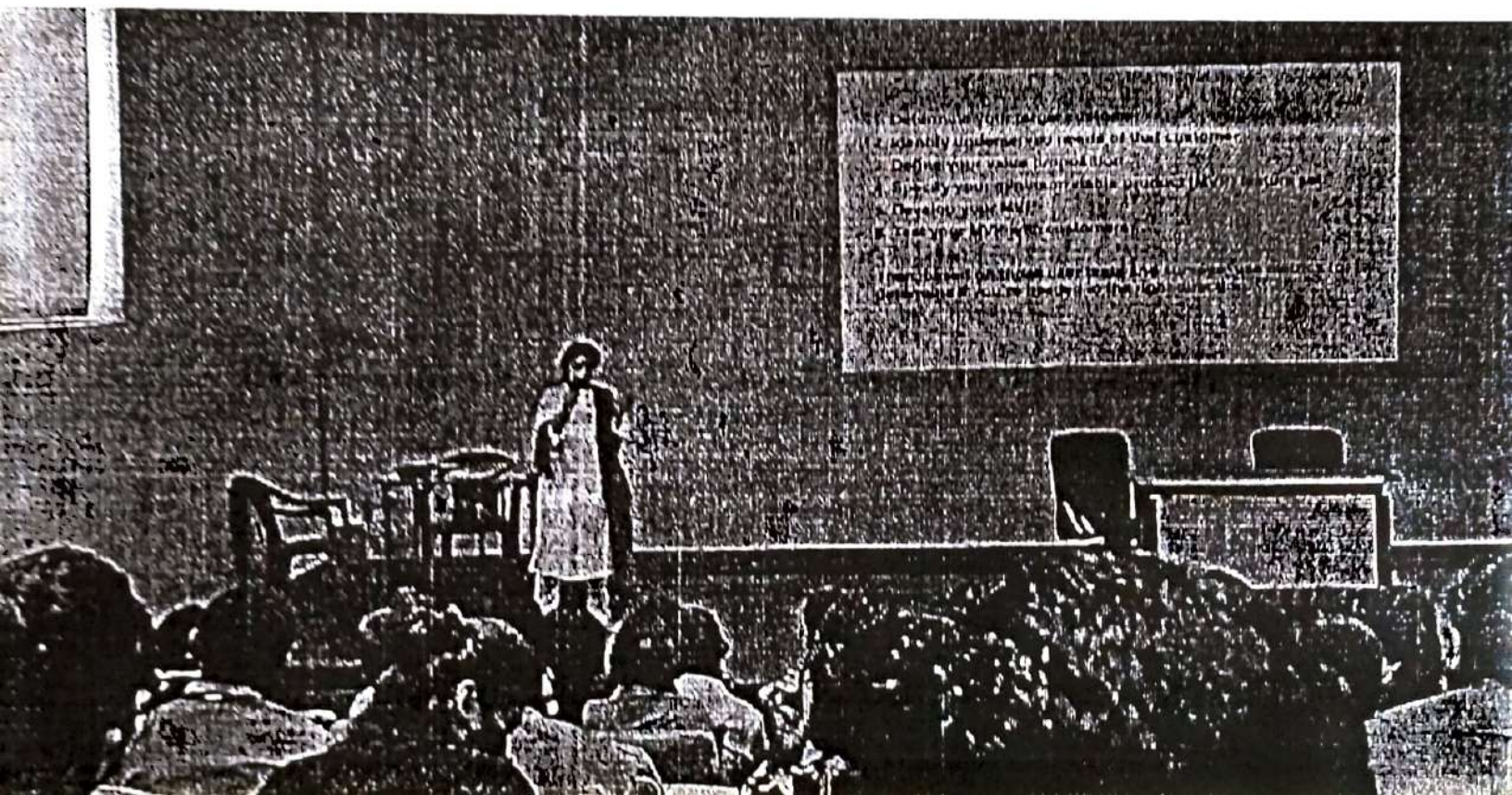

Objectives: The Session was organized with the objective to introduce students to various types of microorganisms, their development and identification techniques.

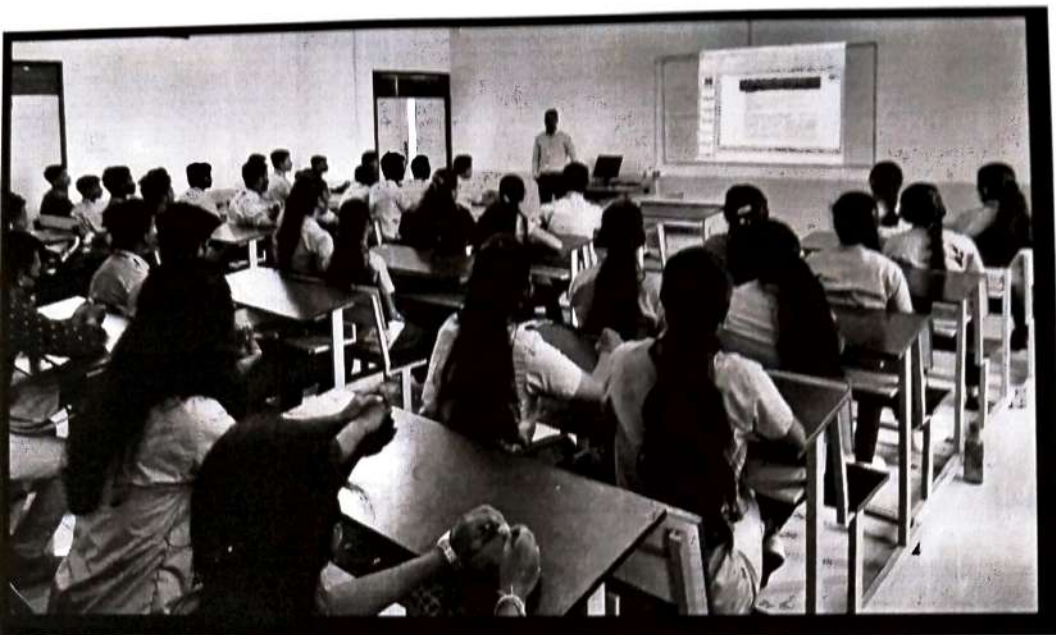
Key Outcome of the Activity: After the session students will able to identify microorganisms by microscopic slides, understand and discuss various identification techniques.
