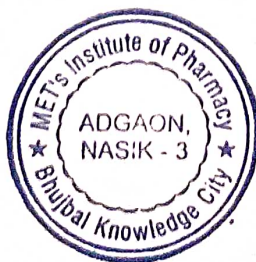



3. Guided Meditation and Yoga workout: 45 minutes.





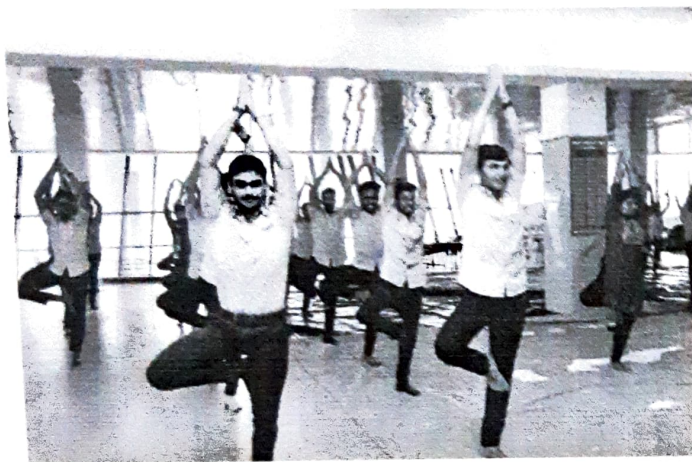

**Key Outcome of the Activity:** After the session students will able to understand the concept of First Aid and give first aid to various conditions.

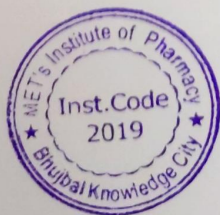

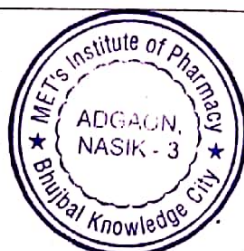
