

## STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY – 2023-24

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- ✓ Student satisfaction survey for 2023-24 was designed emphasizing teaching-learning process and student support system.
- ✓ The survey was conducted by using google-form tool.
- ✓ Responses were analyzed and interpreted as follows:

#### Survey Analysis:

- 1. Percentage of syllabus is covered**  
Response: 83% of students confirmed about above 75% completion of syllabus
- 2. Preparation of teacher for the class**  
Response: More than 97% students stated that teacher prepare satisfactorily & thoroughly for the lecture
- 3. Communication ability of teachers**  
Response: More than 87% of students responded that teachers have effective communication ability
- 4. Teacher's teaching approach**  
Response: Around 87% of the students responded that teaching approach of teachers are good to excellent
- 5. Fairness of Internal Evaluation Process**  
Response: 88 % students were satisfied and rated internal evaluation process as fair
- 6. Assignment Performance Discussion**  
Response: Almost 82% students confirmed about regular discussion of assignments
- 7. Institute's active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities**  
Response: Around 81 % students agreed to the active initiation of institute for better internship, exchange and field visit provisions apart from academic curriculum
- 8. Cognitive, social and emotional growth by teaching and mentoring**  
Response: More than 84% of students mentioned about their very well to significant growth in cognitive, social and emotional domain by teaching and mentoring process
- 9. Awareness about expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes**  
Response: More than 85% students responded affirmatively that every time teachers inform them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes

**10. Opportunities to learn and grow**

Response: 85% of students agreed that institute provides multiple and frequent opportunities to learn and grow

**11. Illustration of the concepts through examples and application**

Response: Almost 87% students stated that almost every time teacher explains concepts through examples and application for thorough understanding

**12. Necessary follow up of assigned task**

Response: Almost 84 % students stated that mentor and teacher take necessary follow with assigned task regularly.

**13. Identification of individuals' strength and encouragement for the same**

Response: Around 79% of students agreed that teachers and mentors help to identify their strength and encourage them respectively.

**14. Identification of individuals' weaknesses and help to overcome them**

Response: Around 82% students positively responded that every time mentors help to identify their weakness and help to overcome it.

**15. Engagement of students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process**

Response: Almost 83 % students agreed that they are actively engaged in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process

**16. Use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies**

Response: Almost 85% of students strongly affirmed that student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies are used to a moderate to great extent

**17. Encouragement to participate in extracurricular activities**

Response: 85 % students agreed about their encouragement from mentor and teachers for active participation in extracurricular activities for overall personality development.

**18. Inculcation of soft skills, life skills and employability skills by institute**

Response: 88% of the students confirmed that efforts are made for inculcation of soft skills, life skills and employability skills by the institute at a larger extent

**19. Percentage of teachers use ICT tools**

Response: Almost 88 % students stated that more than 70 % teachers of institute use ICT tools for teaching learning process.

**20. Overall quality of teaching-learning process**

Response: 82 % students agreed that overall quality of teaching-learning process at the institute is very good.
