In the last session of day 01 Prof. Nilesh Chhallare from IOM delivered a lecture on Manners and etiquettes in professional life.


# Day 02: Scope of Pharmacy Education and Role of Parentas, Teacher and students in Higher education

Sessions useful for First year curriculum and also for university theory and practical examination.




In another session Prof. Nilima Thombare explained the different opportunities in Pharmacy.




Students learned and participated in writing their own resume. They asked their queries and solved by taking help of Ms. Neha.


#### Highlights of Mock Interview


- Two panels have conducted interview in HOD cabins of M. Pharm (QA and Pharmaceutics).
