In the last session of day 01 Prof. Nilesh Chhallare from IOM delivered a lecture on Manners and etiquettes in professional life.


Day 02: Scope of Pharmacy Education and Role of Parentas, Teacher and students in Higher education

In another session Mr. Hemant Patil from Inspire, Nashik discussed the role of parentas, teacher and students in Higher education.




Chief Guest interacts with parents and guides the parents about role and responsibility in their wards education and encourages the parents to involve in all student activities for the overall development of their ward.






