- $\checkmark$  The survey was conducted by using google-form tool.
- ✓ Responses were analyzed and interpreted as follows:

## **Survey Analysis:**

- Percentage of syllabus is covered Response: 84 % of students confirmed about above 85% completion of syllabus
- 2. Preparation of teacher for the class Response: More than 95% students stated that teacher prepare satisfactorily & thoroughly for the lecture
- 3. Communication ability of teachers

Response: More than 89% of students responded that teachers have effective communication ability

### 4. Teacher's teaching approach

Response: Around 85% of the students responded that teaching approach of teachers are good to excellent

**5.** Fairness of Internal Evaluation Process Response: 95 % students were satisfied and rated internal evaluation process as fair

# 6. Assignment Performance Discussion Response: Almost 76% students confirmed about regular discussion of assignments

7. Institute's active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities

Response: Around 77 % students agreed to the active initiation of institute for better internship, exchange and field visit provisions apart from academic curriculum
